



Duct Tape Wallet

Activity Guide

Supplies Needed

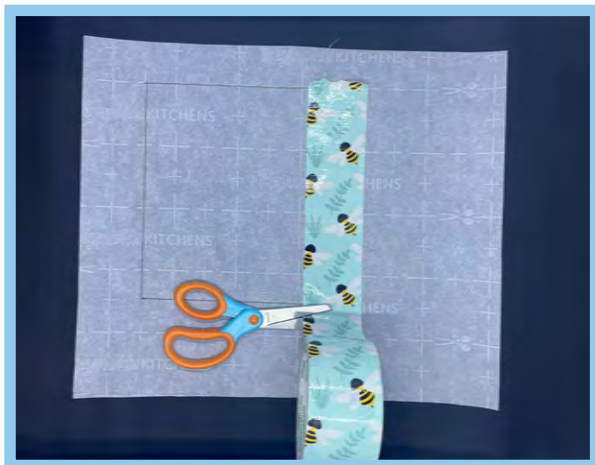
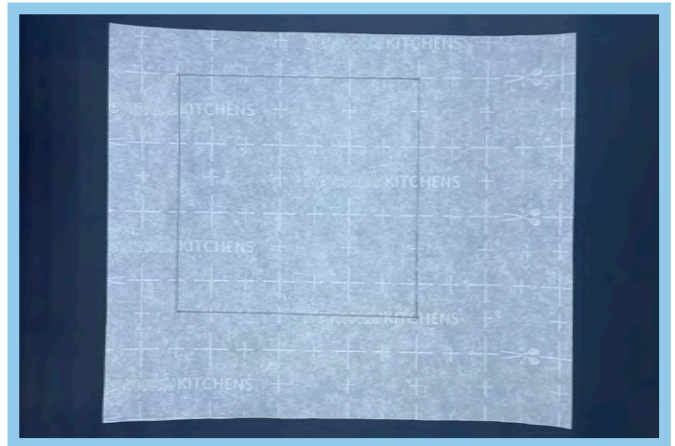
- 2 rolls of Duct Tape - 1 print and 1 solid color
- 2 Velcro strips
- Scissors
- Parchment paper
- Pencil

Instructions

IMPORTANT TIP:

Before cutting: Stick the duct tape to the parchment paper ONLY. Not the table.

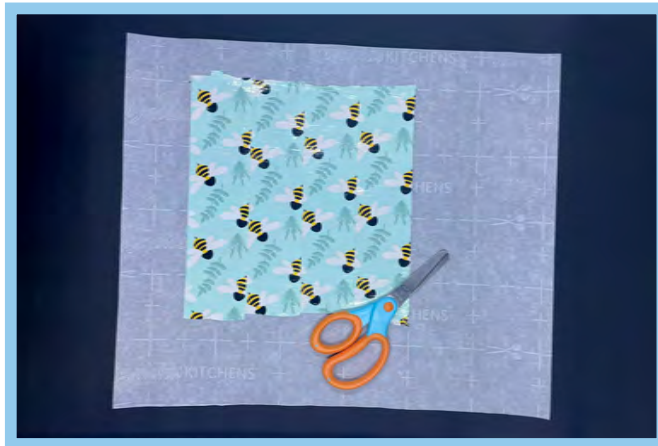
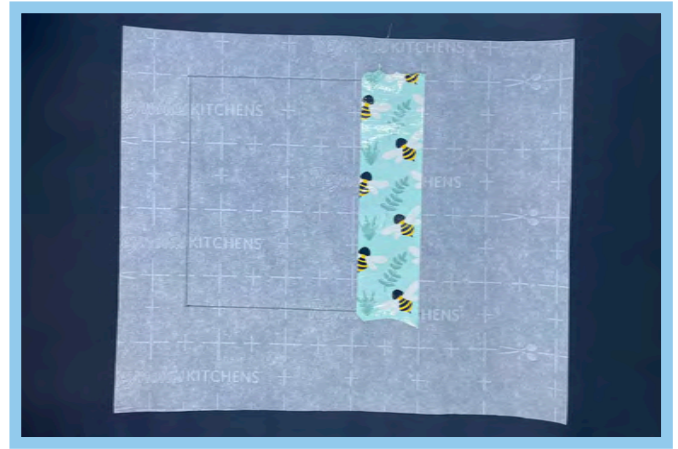
1 Draw an 8" x 8" square on parchment paper.



2 Cut an 8" strip of printed duct tape. This is the outside of the wallet.

Place the strip sticky-side down in the top of the square.

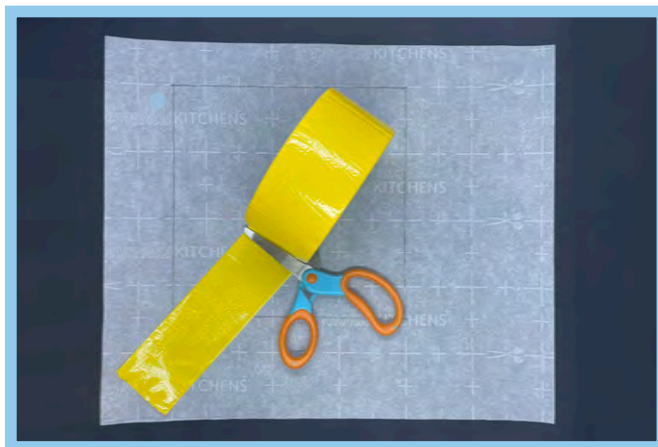
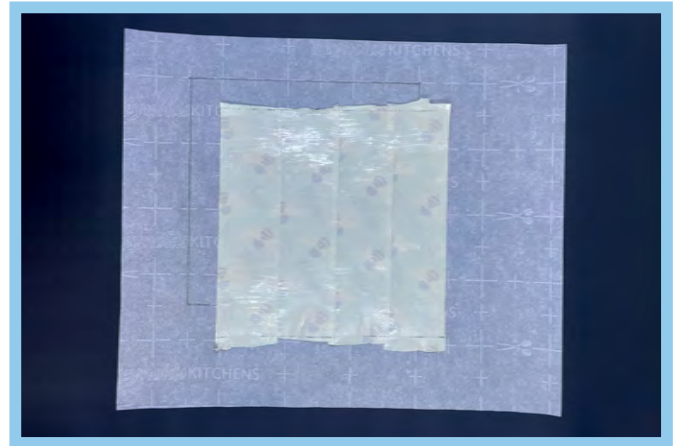


Cut a 2nd strip of the same tape, overlapping the last piece slightly as you put it down. Repeat 2 more times for a total of 4 strips of tape in the square.

Peel the sheet of tape from the parchment paper and flip it over so it's sticky side up.

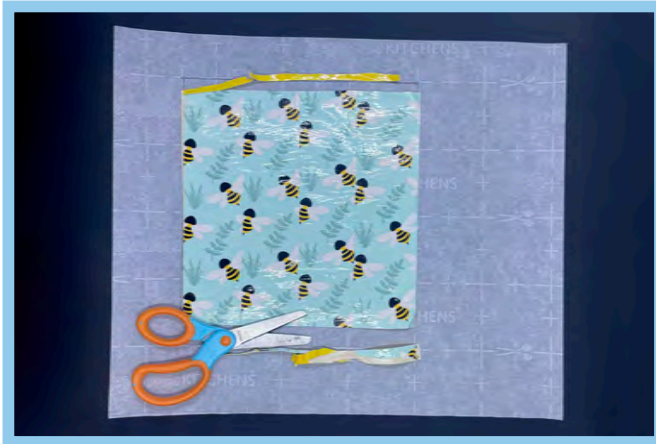
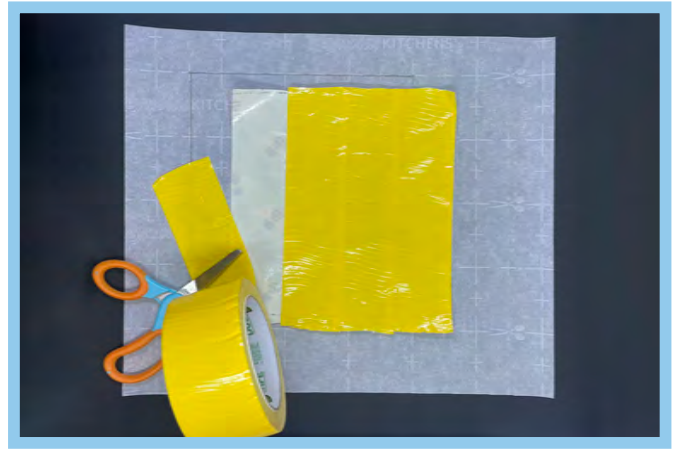


Cut 4 strips of solid colored duct tape.

Lay them on top of the sticky part, overlapping each piece slightly. This is the inside of the wallet.



Cut excess tape from all sides to remove any exposed sticky parts.

Cut 2 pieces of printed duct tape to fold over on the top and bottom of the sheet. Trim as needed.

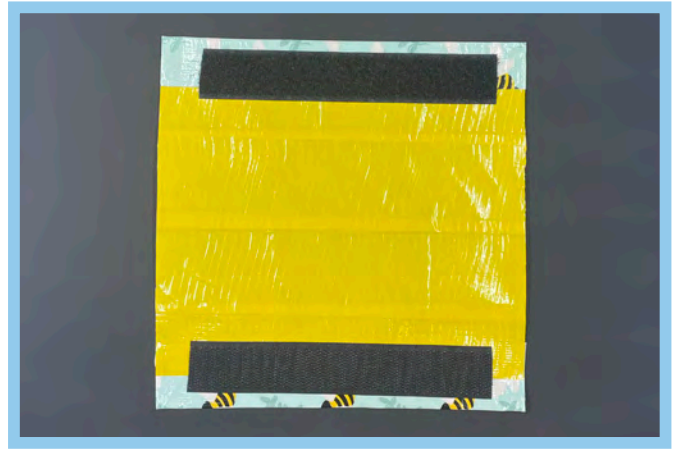


With the solid color facing up, peel the strip off the back of one of the Velcro pieces and press it down near the top of the sheet.

Repeat Step 10 with the bottom of the sheet.



Fold the sheet in half to form the wallet.

Cut 1 piece of printed tape and fold along the bottom of the wallet for reinforcement.



Cut 2 pieces of printed tape and fold over the 2 short sides of the wallet to close it in. Cut off extra tape as needed.
